Veneers are thin sheets of porcelain that cover the front of the tooth, correcting discolorations or chips in the teeth, or reshaping teeth to look better, larger or straighter. Performed by a skilled and experienced dentist, they are truly a form of artwork and can provide the perfect smile.

Dr. Orsatti begins the process of making veneers by first taking photographs and models of the teeth and deciding what changes need to be made. Once the new look is agreed upon with the patient, the actual work begins in the patient's mouth. Dr. Orsatti works diligently to insure that the color, shape and size of the veneers will provide the patient with the desired smile.

The aligners are generally not visible in the mouth; they are made of clear plastic and are smooth and comfortable. They don't irritate the mouth or gums and are removable, making it easier to eat and brush your teeth. The patient must have a full set of adult teeth and the dedication to wear the aligners. The Orsatti Dental Group offers a complimentary whitening system treatment to Invisalign patients.

Mark Habenicht originally went to Dr. Orsatti to have his wisdom teeth removed. Dr. Orsatti asked Mark if he'd ever considered straightening his teeth, which he had, but he'd never bothered to do it. Other emerging technologies that are being utilized in the practice are all-porcelain crowns, which remove the dark shadow at the gum line caused by older metal-based crowns. New porcelain crowns are stronger and provide more support for the tooth and have a more appealing cosmetic appearance.
